- **S + needn't + have + V<sub>3/ed</sub>** ( dùng để diễn đạt việc đáng lẽ không cần phải làm ở QK)

- **S + didn't need + to V** ( không cần phải làm )

**- Bị động: S vật + need + Ving// to be V<sub>3/ed</sub>**

4. **S + should (not) have V<sub>3/ed</sub>: lẽ ra nên/k nên**

II. MODAL VERBS IN THE PASSIVE VOICE

(Bị động của khiếm khuyết động từ)

Modal verbs (can, will, shall, may, could, would, must, ought to...)

1. **A : S + modal verb + V<sub>0</sub> + O**

**P: S + modal verb + be + V<sub>3/ed</sub> + by + O**

Ex: They *will invite* Tom to the party.

Tom **will be invited** to the party.

2. **A: S + modal verb + have + V<sub>3/ed</sub> + O**

**P: S + modal verb + have + been + V<sub>3/ed</sub> + by O**

Ex: They *can't have made* this product by hand.

This product **can't have been made** by hand.
